

Chicken Wire - a summer kerchief designed by Sara Delaney



You will need: US size G/6/4.00mm crochet hook Yarn, 1 skein each Elsebeth Lavold Visilk color 04 and 07 You will have enough yardage to make 2 kerchiefs in opposite colors. scissors tapestry needle

abbreviations:
MC - main color
ch - chain
sc - single crochet
ea - each
sk - skip
st(s) - stitch(es)
sp - space
sl st - slip stitch
CC - contrast color



With MC - ch131, sc in 2nd ch from hook and ea ch across (130)sc

Row 1 - ch3, turn, sk 2sts, sc in 3rd st, *ch5, sk 4 sts, sc in next st, Repeat from * across ending 2sc before end of row.

Row 2 - ch3, turn, sc in next ch5 sp, *ch5, sc in next ch5 sp, Repeat from * across, ending in last ch5 sp. Repeat R2, ending with last row: ch3, turn, sc in next ch5 sp, ch5, sc in next ch5 sp(point of the triangle). Fasten off.

Edging - Join yarn to sc at end of Row 1, ch1, 2sc in same st, 1sc in next st, *2sc in end of next row, 1sc in sc at end of next row, 3sc in end of next row, Repeat from * to point, 7sc in ch5 sp(point), **1sc in sc at end of next row, 2sc in end of next row, 3sc in end of next row, Repeat from ** to corner, 1sc in last sc, 2sc in end of last row, 3sc in end of Row 1, 1sc in bottom of ea ch across, join with sl st to first sc. Fasten off.

Join CC to any sc, ch 1, sc in next st and in ea st around remembering to place 3sc in center sc at ea corner and 3sc in 4th sc of 7sc at point.

Fasten off and weave in ends. Block to open the stitch pattern.
